


Songdo Hanok Village


Incheon is famous for its clams. In particular, there are a number of restaurants that specialize in grilled clams and provide an ocean view along the beaches of Yeongjong.



Public Transportation in Incheon

Use public transportation in Incheon just by using a single transportation card or T-money. Transfer discounts are available for the subway and bus. It is very simple to purchase and use a transportation card, so please read the information below carefully to enjoy all the benefits.

Subway

Incheon Line 1: International Business District Station (Songdo)-Gyeyang Station

Incheon Line 2: Geomdanoryu Station-Unyeon Station

Line 7: Kkachiul Station-Seongnam station

Suin Bundang Line: Incheon Station-Oido Station (Siheung-si, Gyeonggi-do)

Basic Fare: KRW 1,250 (when a transportation card is used)

*The fare is increased by KRW 100 in accordance with the distance.

Bus

Main Line (Blue Bus):

Operated for long distances within Incheon Metropolitan City (Card: KRW 1,250 / Cash: KRW 1,300)

Branch Line (Green Bus):

Operated between stops for the Blue Bus and the subway (Card: KRW 950 / Cash: KRW 1,000)

Higher-Grade Bus: Rapidly connects major bases (Yeongjong-bound: Card: KRW 1,650 / Cash: KRW 2,400)

Provincial Bus (Red Bus): Nonstop bus (Card & Cash: KRW 2,650)

M Bus: Provincial express bus (Card: KRW 2,600 / Cash: KRW 2,900)

Taxi

General Taxi: Basic fare of KRW 3,800 or more (for the first 2 km)

- * Afterwards, KRW 100 is added for every 135 m.
- * An extra charge of 20% of the basic fare is added to the fare from midnight to 4:00

Luxury Taxi: Basic fare of KRW 6,500 or more (for the first 3 km)

* Afterwards, KRW 200 is added for every 151 m.

+ Transportation Card

Used for: All types of public transportation, including the subway and bus.


Transfer Discount: Get a discount when transferring between the subway and bus

* The transfer must be within 30 minutes of getting off public transportation in order to receive the discount.

Buy at: T-Money Card Vending Machines at the subway station / convenience stores displaying the T-money symbol.

Fare: KRW 3,000 (for the card); Cards can be charged for KRW 1,000 or more.

Refund the balance after charging: GS Convenience Stores, 7-Eleven, other convenience stores (365 Plus, lalavla), some charging newsstands (KRW 20,000 or less), CU, Ministop, Emart 24 (KRW 30,000 or less), T-money Service Center within the subway station (KRW 50,000 or less)





+ One-time Subway Card

This is a one-time-use card bought at any vending machine installed in a subway station and used only on the day of purchase. An additional KRW 500 is needed as a card deposit. When arriving at the destination subway station, place the card in the card collector and the card deposit will be returned.

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


